



RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Competitor's age is as at date of competition. All programming requests will be taken into consideration (if notified at time of entry), however the program will not be altered or delayed once finalised.

Troupe time limit is 4 minutes, including on & off the floor, and is to be adhered to. Troupe events will be divided into age groups based on entries. Age groups U/10, U/13, U/16 and open age/adult. Age is taken from the oldest competitor in the troupe. Troupes must contain a minimum of 8 dancers. A separate section will be run for small groups of 4 to 7 persons conforming to international criteria. No dancer may perform in more than one troupe per style.

All troupe's music is to be on a good quality, clearly labeled CD. This needs to be sent to Donna Bradley at P.O. Box 300, Glen Waverley VIC 3150, as all music will be loaded onto computer. A back up copy should be provided with burnt CD'S.

Competitors are eligible to compete in their own age group only. Sections or age divisions may be combined if less than 6 entries are received by closing date of entries. No videoing of troupe sections is permitted. Videoing of solos permitted only with the purchase of a video license.

We expect all solo and duo events to marshal

All adjudicators need to be prepared to use PDF for each round.

No head spins or windmills in any event: No acrobatics in solo or duo and trio events. The adjudicators' decision is final and no discussion will be entered into. Any protests are to be in writing to the organisers within 15 minutes of the alleged breach.

No responsibility will be accepted for lost property of any person at the competition. Dancers and their parents/guardian must accept that in dance there is an element of risk and that they must be responsible for the taking of every precaution to minimize that risk. The organisers reserve the right to decide on any matters not covered by these rules and their decision will be final. Entry will constitute acceptance of these rules & conditions.

I.D.O World selections. Competitors entry fees covers I.D.O registration. All events winners and place getters are eligible to represent Australia in an official World Championship. Travel vouchers apply to some events.

The organisers must be advised as soon as possible if the winning person is taking up the offer to represent Australia.
